

What you can do to help keep your Sewers Clean?

- Use Liquid Laundry Detergent instead of Powdered . It might look like it dissolves, but it will disburse in your washer and when it gets to the Sewer lines it clumps back together, causing clogged and blocked lines.
- Watch what you put down your garbage disposal. One of the worst things you could put down your disposal are egg shells, those tiny pieces will stick in the screens and over time they will cause a plugged screen, causing it to back up.

Its always good to think about these few helpful tips to save you time and money.

In years past the 'first major storm' has raised havoc with power failures and sewer back-ups. We are on the right track and the District deserves an attaboy!

COMP PLAN

As described in the 2006 Wastewater Facilities Plan, the current plant is an activated sludge facility with a treatment capacity of 4.07 mgd maximum month flow and as many of you may know is located within the flood plain of the Snohomish River, along the banks of Ebey Slough, west of Sunnyside Boulevard.

The proposed new wastewater treatment facility will treat a maximum month flow of 6.36 mgd at a site near the intersection of SR 204 and Sunnyside Boulevard, approximately 1 mile south of the existing facility. This design flow will allow treatment of sanitary sewer flows through the year 2028. The new plant is currently in design, with construction of Phase 1 beginning in 2008 and completion expected in 2010.
