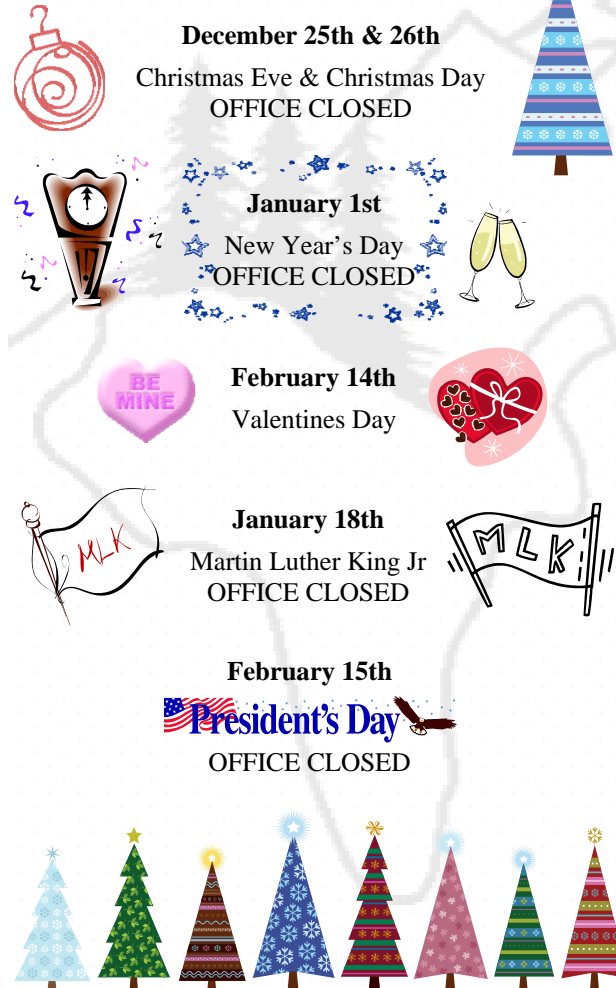
Reason # 3
